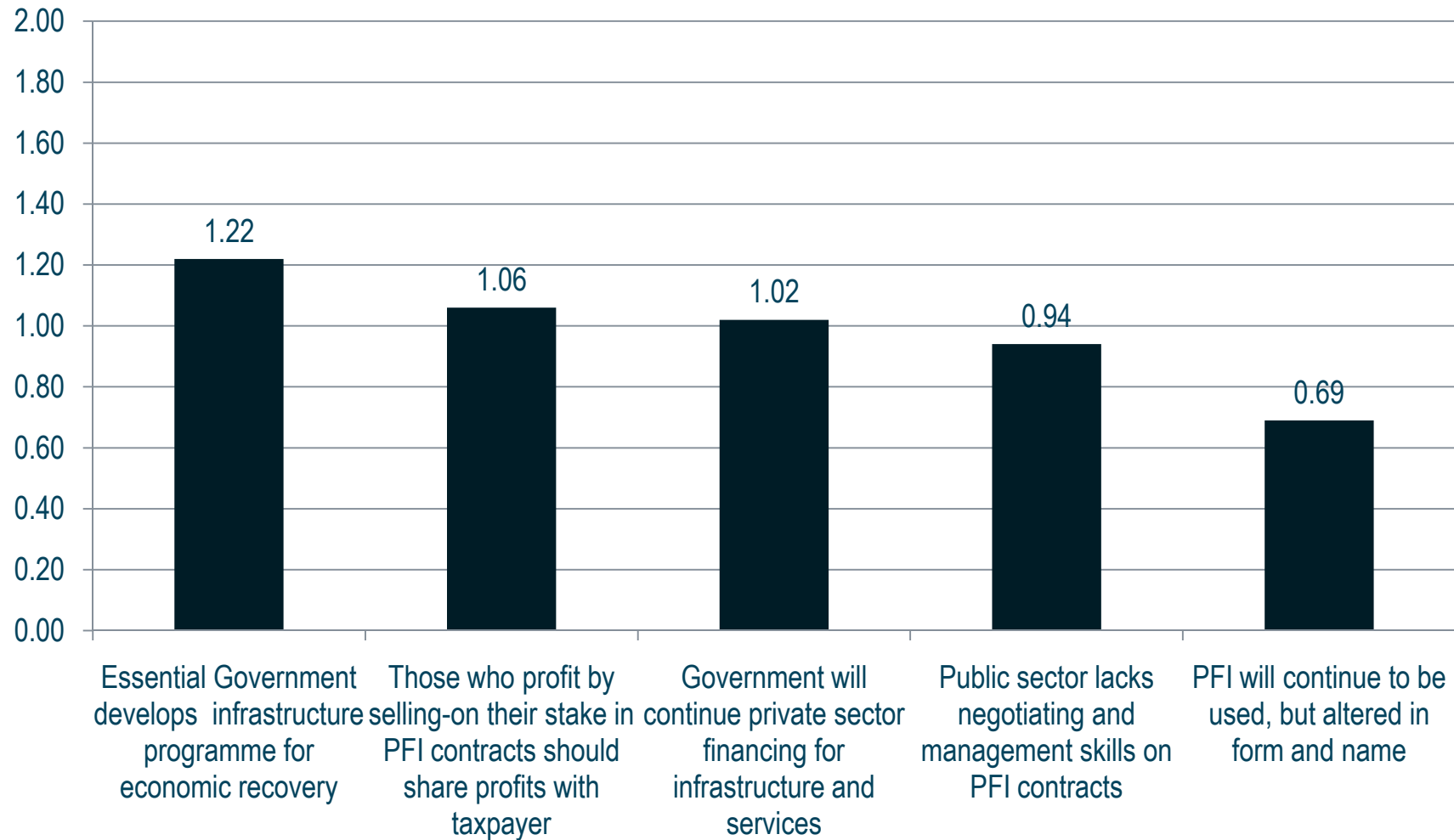
- Survey of 158 MPs

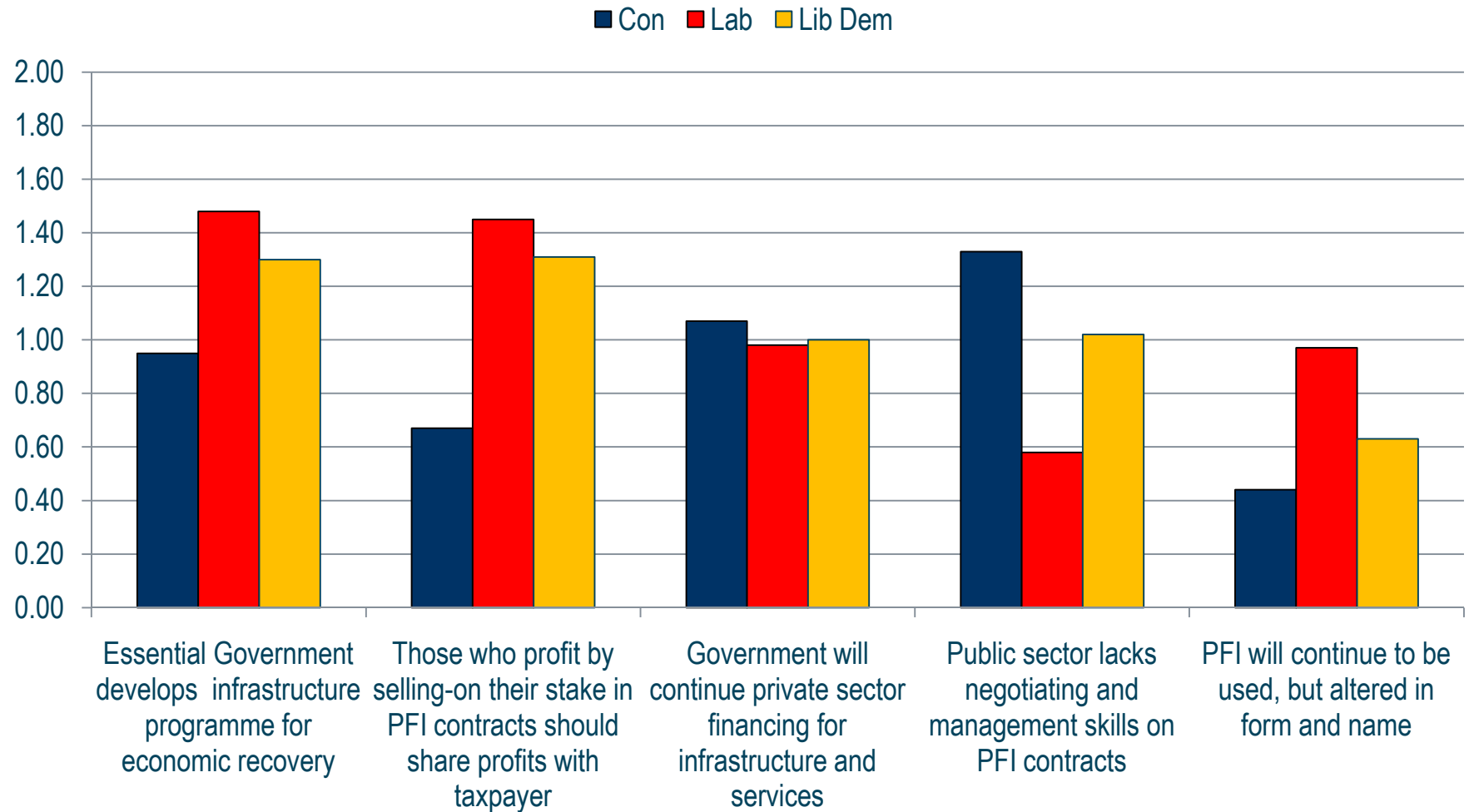

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Conclusion

- Remarkably high levels of agreement with all statements, including across each of the different parties
- Expectancy that PFI will continue, but reservations about public sector's ability to get value
- Widespread support for 'payback' mechanism
